Science for Prevention: Identifying Potential Breast Carcinogens

Tuesday, February 13 | 10-11am PST | Virtual

In this webinar from the <u>Collaborative for Health and Environment (CHE)</u>, you will learn about the nearly 280 chemicals that induce mammary tumors in rodents and over 600 additional chemicals that stimulate estrogen or progesterone signaling.

This webinar will also discuss the role of endocrine disrupting chemicals in the development of breast cancer, and how they identified the chemicals potentially involved in breast cancer.
